The *Municipal Development and Lending Fund (MDLF)* has received funds from the Agence Française de Développement (the French Development Agency - AFD) towards the cost of the *Economic and Urban Multi Site Regeneration Project- MSR Project*. It is intended that part of the proceeds of these funds will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the “*Design, Supply & Install of Jericho Slaughter House and related infrastructure*”.
2. The *Municipal Development & Lending Fund (MDLF)* now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for *Design, Supply & Install of Jericho Slaughterhouse and related infrastructure*. The site is located south east of Jericho City on about 19000 m² land east of Jericho City. The proposed building consists of 2184 m² reinforced concrete structure with limestone with double masonry for isolation as per concept drawings. The task also includes supply and installation of abattoir equipment and accessories for cattle, sheep and chicken (Cattle 35 head per week, Sheep/Goats 150 head per week and poultry, and (500 birds per hour maximum). The work also includes blood collection and treatment, wastewater pretreatment, Project, pumping station, Wastewater force main, and 76mm water supply to the proposed site. In addition to the parking and landscaping within the facilities.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations

for IPF Borrowers, *July 2016 revised November 2017*”, and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
